POW-WOW WITH PASTOR BRIAN

As we at Heritage Church continue to live into the adaptive challenges faced by our community, I would like to update you on a few key developments regarding leadership. The first is that our Nominating Team is in place and we will be electing them on June 4th at a Congregational Meeting immediately following the worship service. Please attend this service as it is important to show our love and support for the people who have taken on this task, as we prayerfully discern whom God is calling to be our leaders as we move through this next season of our life together. Secondly, but just as important, I want to let you know not only who but what the Nominating Team will be looking for as we move through this process.

The Nominating Team will be looking for five individuals to come onto Session (the church board), who are motivated and looking to join together in discerning what God is calling Heritage to be and do in the coming years. The folks, along with one elder who has a year left on their term, will be divided into three classes of two people each. The goal of this move is to create a church environment where teams of Session have a great deal more flexibility and autonomy than they may have enjoyed in the past. Each elder will liaise with the chair person of each of our five ministry teams, as opposed to chairing the teams themselves. It is hoped that this will create a ministry environment where mission is able to thrive and people feel energized and empowered as opposed to tired and burned out. In short, the nature of Session work is going to change somewhat.

Many of you, if you have served on Session before here or even at another church, may still be under the impression that Session meetings tend to be 3-4 hour slugfests, where impassioned people argue with one another as to how to spend the budget of the church. This was probably more myth than reality to begin with, but I assure whatever the truth of the matter may have been, this is no longer the case. To be sure, elders of the church are a passionate bunch and there are sometimes disagreements but more often than not the Session is able to come to a consensus. Notice though, that I did not say compromise. As we continue to discern the will of God for our church it is important to note that coming to an understanding of what we believe God is calling us to do is not a compromise but rather a willingness to trust one another and to trust God.

Session meetings these days are marked by laughter and joy and deep desire to be about the work which God is placing before us. If we do disagree it is ok because we love one another and there is no greater gift the church can give to the world than disagreeing with one another in love. Far from trying to give a hard sell as to why you should be on Session, there are as many reasons not to be as there are reasons to take the faithful plunge, it is my hope that those who will be contacted by the Nominating Team will take some time to pray and talk about ways they are being called to leadership, and to trust that the Nominating Team is not taking its duties lightly, but has prayerfully considered that you are the right person to help lead Heritage Church into the work which God is placing before us.
